



## **NAPF Affiliate Application**

Foundation (NAPF). I understand and agree to the following Affiliate requirements:

- 1. Shared Vision and Mission** Affiliate organizations endorse and agree to work to fulfill the vision, mission and goals of NAPF. Our Vision is a world at peace, free of the threat of war and free of weapons of mass destruction. Our Mission is to advance initiatives to eliminate the nuclear weapons threat to all life, to foster the global rule of law, and to build an enduring legacy of peace through education and advocacy.
- 2. Approved Goals** A concrete set of goals and corresponding action plan developed by Affiliate members must be approved by NAPF.
- 3. Representation** Approval of this application designates your organization as an Affiliate of NAPF. While approval allows Affiliates to use the name of the Foundation in their materials, i.e. "(name of your organization), an Affiliate of the Nuclear Age Peace Foundation," it is understood that Affiliate organizations do not represent NAPF and are not authorized to speak on behalf of NAPF.
- 4. Regular Reports** Affiliates agree to submit quarterly reports on their activities suitable for publication on the Foundation's website and/or newsletters.
- 5. Expand Membership** Affiliates commit themselves to expanding the membership of NAPF in their respective regions.
- 6. Non-violence** Affiliates agree to adhere to principles of nonviolence in all their activities.
- 7. Non-profit** Affiliates conduct their activities in accord with the Foundation's mandate as an educational and advocacy organization (US Affiliates can have no more than 10% of activities and resources devoted directly to lobbying).
- 8. Non-partisan** Affiliates behave in a strictly non-partisan manner, without endorsement of specific electoral candidates. (Individuals associated with the

Affiliate organizations may, of course, engage in partisan or lobbying activities in their personal capacities.)

I understand that NAPF will provide the following support and resources to Affiliate organizations:

1. Regular updates on Foundation positions on key issues.
2. Sharing of information on Affiliate activities on its website.
3. Backing of an organization with consultative status to the United Nations.
4. A limited number of NAPF newsletters and publications for educational and outreach use (if requested).

In addition to agreeing to and endorsing the above requirements, I hereby submit the following information for consideration with this application for Affiliate status:

1. A description of the current or proposed organization, including goals, projects and activities, structure, size, location and formal [tax] status.
2. A brief description of the individuals involved in the leadership of the current or proposed organization, including names, educational background and experience.
3. Contact information: mailing address, e-mail and website, if applicable.
4. A brief statement about how you plan to further the goals of NAPF in your region.

Until your application has been approved, please do not begin to engage in activities linking your organization to NAPF, including through media releases, press conferences, or other forums.
