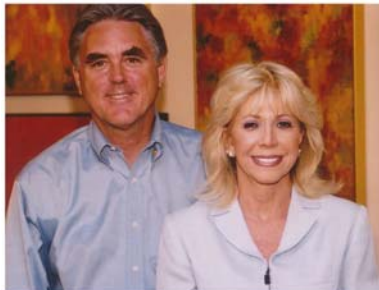

Peace Foundation Announces 20th Anniversary Campaign Co-Chairs
