verifiable and irreversible disarmament of nuclear weapons. “We believe the first step to abolishing nuclear weapons is changing the way people think about them,” said Steven Crandell, Director of Public Affairs for the Foundation. “This DVD is a wake-up call about nuclear weapons. It also provides an explanation of what can be done to make the world a safer place and how we all can make a difference.

“Getting rid of nuclear weapons is, after all, common sense. We work hard to prepare for all kinds of disasters. Do we take steps to reduce or eliminate the threat from fire, flood, famine and epidemics? Of course, we do. Can we take steps to eliminate the threat nuclear weapons? Of course, we can. Nuclear disarmament is just a form of disaster prevention. We made them. We can un-make them.”
