Daniel Ellsberg is America's best-known whistleblower for his role in releasing the Pentagon Papers in 1971, a move that harkened an end to U.S. involvement in the Vietnam War and exposed government deceit and illegality at the highest levels. His legendary story has been recounted in the 2010 Oscar-nominated documentary: *The Most Dangerous Man in America*, and in his book *Secrets*. Earlier in his career, he served for three years in the U.S. Marines Corps before earning a Ph.D. in Economics from Harvard. In the 1960s, he became a strategic analyst at the RAND Corporation and consultant to the Department of Defense and the White House, specializing in the command and control of nuclear weapons, nuclear war plans, and crisis decision-making. Since the end of the Vietnam War, Daniel Ellsberg has been a lecturer, writer and activist on the dangers of the nuclear era and unlawful interventions.
