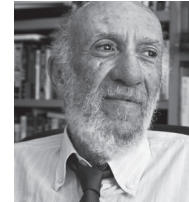

He was a Special Rapporteur for the UN on Human Rights in the Palestinian territories from 2008–2014. He is the author and editor of numerous books including *Legality and Legitimacy in Global Affairs*.

Among other leadership positions, he is one of 50 Councilors from around the world on the World Future Council. He is the author and editor of numerous books and articles related to achieving peace in the Nuclear Age.
